Science Index — cumulative journal score, calculation method is presented at <http://elibrary.ru/>.

Impact Factor (IF) in Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI) is calculated based on the average number of citations a journal receives in RSCI in the previous two or five years. The citation data is taken from the publications of the year which the IF is calculated for. When calculating the IF, the number of references in the target year from all the processed RISC journals made to the articles published in a targeted journal during the previous 2 or 5 years is divided by the total number of articles this journal. In fact this rate represents the average number of citations per article in a journal. For example, when calculating the five-year IF for 2013 the total number of citations made in 2013 to articles published in the journal in the period from 2008 to 2012 inclusive is divided by the total number of articles published in the magazine issues for 2008–2011.
